Rules, Guidelines and Registration Information

Camp Rules

- No alcoholic beverages.
- No drugs without a prescription.
- No smoking. All tobacco products are strictly prohibited.
- No guys in girls' cabins at any time.
- No girls in guys cabins at any time.
- No audio-visual equipment (Cell phones, Ipods,
- MP3 players, CD/DVD players, electronic games, Walkman, TVS, radios, etc.).
- Youth must remain on campgrounds at all times.
- Everyone must remain in their assigned sleeping areas from *Lights Out until Wake Up*.
- Each person is expected to clean up after themselves at mealtimes.
- Cabins, lodges, grounds and meeting rooms must be left clean.

Youth Leader Guidelines

- Have 1 female counselor for every 1-5 female students and 1 male counselor for every 1-5 male students.
- Discuss all rules with group before arriving at the retreat.

- Be responsible for registering all participants in their church group.
- Oversee supervision of their church group during the retreat.
- Have all participants, including chaperones, prepare a Medical, Photo and Video Release form. **The form must be notarized.** Bring original and 1 copy to the retreat. Youth Leaders will keep original copy and submit photo copy at retreat registration time.

Counselor (Chaperone) Guidelines

- Must be at least 20 years old.
- Be responsible for, and pray for, the youth assigned to them.
- Enforce the Lights Out Policy.
- Ensure their assigned youth attend all sessions and worship services.
- Encourage reverence and respect during worship services and discipline when necessary.
- Facilitate nightly church group devotions.
- Set a positive example by participating in activities.
- Be prepared to assist with counseling decisions during the worship service.

What To Bring
